1 ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

A major area covered by this department is Tasawwuf, along with its theories, practical trends and history. It also facilitates the study of philosophy, including a wide range of ancient, medieval and modern debates and trends—Greco-Roman, Indian and Chinese philosophical traditions, Islamic philosophical theology (Ilm al-Kalam), and Islamic epistemology and logic.

2 PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The 3-year Degree programme is organised into 6 semesters. Completion requires successful completion of Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) and the Term-End Examination for every course. Core Courses are compulsory papers of the department taught across all six semesters. Elective Courses are department-specific specialization papers, each carrying a dedicated assignment component. Teaching follows 9 periods of 45 minutes daily, 7:45 a.m. to 4:10 p.m.
