1 ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

Established in 2020 within the Kulliyyah of Social Science, the department offers undergraduate and postgraduate programs focusing on the history of Islamic civilization, world history, psychology, anthropology and social development studies—building a broad and comprehensive worldview.

2 PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The 3-year Degree programme is organised into 6 semesters. Completion requires successful completion of Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) and the Term-End Examination for every course. Core Courses are compulsory papers of the department taught across all six semesters. Elective Courses are department-specific specialization papers, each carrying a dedicated assignment component. Teaching follows 9 periods of 45 minutes daily, 7:45 a.m. to 4:10 p.m.
